Update products in line with feedback, publish summary consultation log on website, determine whether further consultation is required.

Senior Official's check

Seek feedback from Commonwealth, state and territory authorities, amend products as required.

Submit to **Assurance Bod** 

Submit final draft products for endorsement/ recommendation to Skills Ministers.

## **METHODOLOGY**

The Manufacturing Industry Skills Alliance Annual Training Product Development Plan outlines the training products to be developed for the year and the industry imperatives and scope of work required.

These projects will follow the 5 stage methodology, above, which is aligned to the requirements of the Training Package Organising Framework.

For each project a Project Overview and Consultation Strategy is developed which identifies key stakeholders and the communication and consultation methods to facilitate their input.

A Technical Committee is also established to provide expert advice on the Consultation Strategy and the draft training products. At least one round of public consultation is held within each project and a summary Consultation Log is published to our website at key points in the project.
